As part of the Development & Communications team, under the direction of the **Senior Communications Specialist**, you will help advance the organization through community awareness campaigns, program promotions, and fundraising communications.

In this role you will:

- Assist the Development & Communications team by attending and covering community programs and special events as assigned to secure content for digital communications, including web, social media, and eblasts.
- Have the opportunity to advance projects that both support the Development & Communications team and your internship outcome goals. Possible projects include news/blog posts, print media, eblasts, and social campaigns.
- Support mission-based, organization-wide initiatives through on-brand, cohesive messaging.

To be successful you will need:

- Be 18 years of age and a rising Sophomore, Junior, or Senior enrolled in a relevant 4-year degree program.
- Be familiar with or majoring in a field relevant to developing content for social media, photo and video production, and creative copywriting.
- Experience with Canva, CapCut, Later, and WordPress or similar tools is preferred.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- An eye for visual aesthetics and ability to apply brand standards in both writing and design.
- Humor, both tasteful and educational, but also trendy and creative.
- Interest in nature-related and conservation-related issues.
- Work on a seasonal, part-time, as-needed basis with evenings and weekends.
- To attend Wildlands Conservancy's community programming, conservation events, and meetings with the Communications team as assigned.
- Possession of a valid driver's license.
- A personal smartphone for photography, and other apps as assigned.
